

Volunteers needed for community service event

BELTON — Volunteers are needed for the city of Belton Youth Advisory Commission's One Community One Day event to help the community from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. March 31, said Sandy Slade, recreation and events director.

Individuals, groups, churches and families will meet no later than 8 a.m. at the Harris Community Center to divide into groups for service projects at homes around the community. The homes were selected based on an application process that determined the needs of homeowners unable to perform basic functions around the house, including yard work and light touchup painting. Homeowners generally do not have the support system in place to assist, and rely on the volunteers of One Community One Day, now in its second year, to help.

A volunteer meeting and workshop is scheduled for 7:15 p.m. March 21 in the Evans room at the Harris Community Center, 401 Alexander St. in Belton.
